Get ready to roll some dice with Sue Harvie's rhythm reading dice game, 'Gonna Roll' from her book F-U-N 'n Games Galore along with a Literature based additional piece inspired by the book 'Say Zoop!' written by Hervé Tullet. Both pieces may be performed using originally scored non-pitched percussion or on found sound. Both activities focus on curricular outcomes that include experiences in form, rhythm/beat, reading and performing through various media (speech, singing, body percussion, non-pitched percussion and found sound).

Through the art of storytelling and a little imagination Deb Ziolkoski will whisk you away to the Queen's Garden to meet some very Snobby Pears! Discover how easy it is to introduce your students to classical music in a fun, Covid friendly way!
